providing comprehensive psychological,
pedagogical and speech therapy
diagnostic services for children from
birth to 18 years or adult students.

The Counselling Centre is worth contacting when:

- a child or adult learner is experiencing learning difficulties
- has communication or behavioural difficulties.
 - Parents/guardians/adult learners can seek help on their own initiative and be assured that help is provided in a confidential manner.
 - Anything you learn verbally or receive as the conclusion of a comprehensive assessment in the form of a document - is communicated only to you.
 - The counselling centre dosn't share the findings of the diagnosis with anyone other than parents/guardians or adult learners.

Counselling centres are state institutions that are there to help the child and his/her parents/guardians.



If you are concerned about your child's mental development, you are encouraged to contact a Counselling Centre. There is at least one such institution in every county.
